RE: Franklin Knolls – Consideration of Conversion of Community Well to Public Water Main

Dear Scott:

On May 25, 2020, the City of Farmington Hills received the initial request for a watermain improvement informational meeting for the Franklin Knolls Subdivision. This request was facilitated by you. Covid-19 caused some time delay and on April 19, 2022 a Public Informational Meeting was held for Franklin Knolls property owners. Following this meeting, property owners had 60 days to confirm their support of the public water main project. Majority support (50% or more) was required to proceed with the project. After 60 days, 7 out of 138 (5%) property owners were in support of public watermain. With this in mind, the City will not proceed with the Franklin Knolls Public Watermain project at this time since majority support was not obtained.

This consideration is now a closed issue.
